This sight is in the lively "shitamachi" (plebeian) area of Osaka that is lined with colorful signs. Inside the tower with viewing platform, which symbolizes the area, there is a Billiken statue. It's said to be lucky to rub the bottom of its feet.

Fushimi-Inari Taisha Shrine

This is the head shrine out of 30,000 Inari shrines found in Japan. We recommend you to have a walk through Senbon Torii (the corridor with extending red gateways), and to take pictures with this vivid-red scenery which can be found nowhere else.

There are 1388 wild deer living in the park. It is also very popular in the spring because of the beautiful scenery of the cherry blossoms.
