


Four Seasons in Yokohama



Yokohama Chinatown

Boasting 150 years of history with over 500 shops, Yokohama Chinatown is Japan's largest Chinatown and remains one of the best Chinatowns in the world. The main attraction of Yokohama Chinatown is the cuisine offered at its many restaurants and food stalls.



Yokohama Red Brick Warehouse

Maintaining the vestiges of its warehouse past with its elegantly quaint exterior and hosting a variety of small shops, seasonal events, and an oceanfront view of the Yokohama Bay Bridge and Osanbashi Pier, the Yokohama Red Brick Warehouse charms and delights anyone who visits.


Marine & Walk

An open-air mall at waterfront warehouse district. An enticing selection of unique shops line the main avenue, with photogenic spots along the street.



Yamashita Park

The first seaside park in Japan located right in front of Yokohama Port, stretching almost 700 meters from the east side of Osanbashi to Yamashita Pier. It was opened in 1930 by land filling with the rubbles from the Great Kanto Earthquake.

Shin-Yokohama Ramen Museum

Founded in 1994, Shin-Yokohama Ramen Museum is the world's first food-themed amusement park. Locals and tourists flock to this venue to enjoy the flavors of the national dish from renowned shops across Japan all in one stop.

Osanbashi Pier

The Osanbashi Yokohama International Passenger Terminal is a major port where foreign cruise ships dock during international cruises. Surrounded by the sea, it features Yokohama's best views of the Minato Mirai skyline, and the pier is one of the most creative architectural achievements you are ever likely to visit.

Yokohama Cosmo World

The giant ferris wheel with the world's largest clock has now become an iconic feature of Minato Mirai district. This amusement park offers a lot of family-friendly rides and attractions.

Transportation in Yokohama

★ Yokohama One Day Ticket

The ticket can be used for Keikyu Line from Shinagawa station to Yokohama area. Minatomirai Line, Yokohama Municipal Subway Lines and Yokohama city bus (including Akai Kutsu bus) is valid as well.

One day (from Shinagawa Station):

¥1,110/Adult



★ Yokohama-Minatomirai Pass

The Yokohama-Minatomirai Pass allows unlimited rides on local and rapid JR East trains (excluding reserved seats) on the Negishi Line between Yokohama and Shin-Sugita Stations as well as on the Yokohama Minatomirai Line. Use a Yokohama-Minatomirai Pass to enjoy sightseeing and shopping in the Yokohama area.

One day: ¥520/Adult, ¥260/Child

★ Minatomirai Line One Day Ticket

The Minatomirai Line One Day Ticket allows unlimited rides all day on the Minatomirai Line. Furthermore, passengers can get special discount and services at Yokohama Port Museum, Royal Wing cruise, Cupnoodles Museum and other facilities.

One day : ¥460/Adult, ¥230/Child

★ Minato-Burari Ticket

A discount ticket for unlimited rides all day on the subway and city buses from MM21 area, where Yokohama's sightseeing spots are concentrated, to the areas of Sankeien, Yamate, Isezakicho, Chinatown, and the surrounding area of Yamashita Park. Furthermore, passengers can get special discount at more than 80 associated facilities. **Minato Burari Ticket Wide" that includes a roundtrip on municipal subway to "Shin-Yokohama Station" is also available.

One day ticket: ¥500/Adult, ¥250/child

★ Akai Kutsu Bus

"Akai Kutsu" is a bus that runs through the Yokohama Bay area from Sakuragicho-Station and offers you 2 different routes. Enjoy sightseeing in Yokohama in this retro-style bus made in the image of trams!

One day free ride: ¥600/Adult, ¥300/child



★ Baybike

Community Cycle is the system that has docking ports in each area, and you can rent bike at any docking port you like within designate area.

One day: ¥1,500/Adult, ¥1,000/Student or 55 and above
