Tsukimi 月見

Tsukimi, moon viewing parties are held on the evenings when there is a full harvest moon in September. People set up a table with *Susuki* - pampas grass, *Sake*, *Tsukimi-dango* - rice dumplings and assorted seasonal fruits and vegetables as offerings to the moon and appreciate the beauty of the moon.

Ukai 鵜飼

Cormorant fishing, an ancient method of catching *Ayu* (sweetfish or trout-like fish), handling cormorants.

This usually takes place at night under the blazing torches fastened to the prows of fishing boats from May until October.
