






**With KAWAGOE DISCOUNT PASS Premium**  
**On Tobu bus routes**  
**within designated sections!** **get on and off freely!**



**One-point advice**  
 Many city route buses run regularly from Kawagoe Station towards Kura-no-machi area, but if you are heading to the Kura-no-machi area, we recommend you to take the bus at Stop No. ① (W1-1) or ② (W1-2). Bus services are frequent, so you will arrive fast.

# Walk around Kawagoe

**A Kawagoe Hikawa Shrine**

A shrine where the principal guardian deity of Kawagoe is enshrined. The main hall is decorated with elaborate sculptures on the theme of the human figures that appear on floats during the Kawagoe Festival. 'Fishing for fortune' is popular here: this involves using a fishing rod to catch a toy fish with a lucky fortune slip attached.

W1-7 Kawagoe Station East Exit No. ⑦ 10 minutes → W17 Kawagoe Hikawa Shrine (get off)  
 T1 Kawagoe Station East Exit No. ③ 20 minutes → T8 Kawagoe Hikawa Shrine (get off)  
 W1-1~5 Kawagoe Station East Exit No. ①, ②, ⑤ 8 minutes → W9 Kitamachi (get off)

**B Toki no Kane (Time Bell Tower)**

Streets lined with black plaster walls and hinged double doors create a scene typical of the "Little Edo" of Kawagoe. Dominating the central area of Kawagoe, the Toki-no-Kane bell tower is a familiar symbol of the city.

W1-1~6 Kawagoe Station East Exit No. ①, ②, ⑤, ⑥ 7 minutes → W7 Ichibangai (get off)  
 T1 Kawagoe Station East Exit No. ③ 12 minutes → T5 Otemachi (get off) 5-minute walk  
 T1 Kawagoe Station East Exit No. ③ 24 minutes → T12 Ichibangai (get off)

**C Kura no machi (Kurazukuri-style old storehouse)**

Built in the wake of the Great Fire of Kawagoe in 1893, modeled after the style of several kurazukuri buildings that somehow escaped fiery destruction. Catch a glimpse of the atmosphere at the emergence of Japan's Meiji era.

W1-1~6 Kawagoe Station East Exit No. ①, ②, ⑤, ⑥ 7 minutes → W7 Ichibangai (get off)  
 T1 Kawagoe Station East Exit No. ③ 24 minutes → T12 Ichibangai (get off)

**D Taisho-Roman Street**

A shopping district full of retro buildings that give a sense of nostalgia of Japan's beloved Taisho era. In the spring, more than 800 carp streamers flutter in the streets.


W1-1~6 Kawagoe Station East Exit No. ①, ②, ⑤, ⑥ 6 minutes → W6 Naka-cho (get off) or 5 minutes → W5 Renkeiji Temple (get off)  
 W1-7 Kawagoe Station East Exit No. ⑦ 5 minutes → W12 Shimomatsue-cho (get off)

**Either the Ichibangai or Fudanotsuji bus stop is the most convenient for strolling around the kurazukuri-style storehouse buildings.** Apart from the Tobu Koedo Loop Bus, Tobu Bus also operates a bus service that travels via the Kura-no-machi area, departing from the East Bus Stop No. ①②③⑤⑥. If traveling to the Kura-no-machi area, we recommend you to take a bus from either bus stop No. ① (W1-1) or bus stop No. ② (W1-2). Bus services are frequent, so you will arrive fast. You can get on and off freely within the designated travel sections. Even more convenient in combination with city route buses!

※1 It may take some time for the Tobu Koedo Loop Bus (No. ③) to arrive at the Kura-no-machi area, as it travels around various sightseeing spots.  
 ※2 When traveling to Hikawa Shrine, buses departing from bus stop ⑦ are convenient. However, please take care, as these do not go to Ichibangai or Fudanotsuji.
