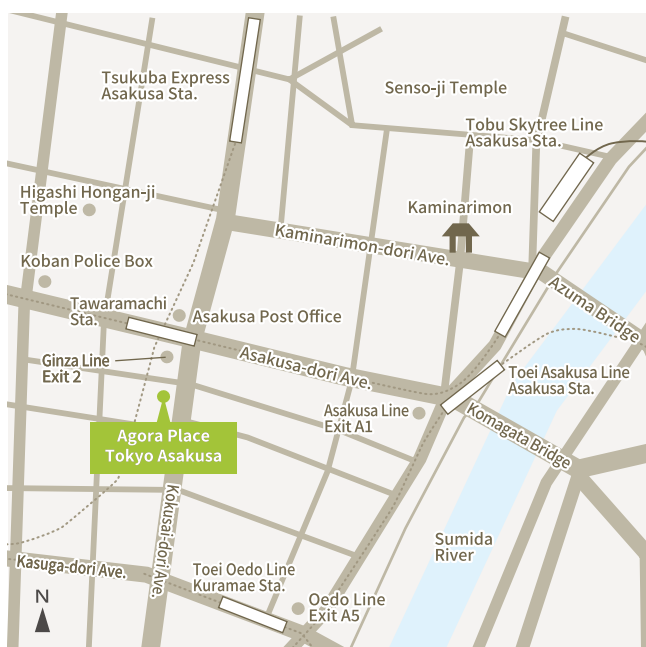

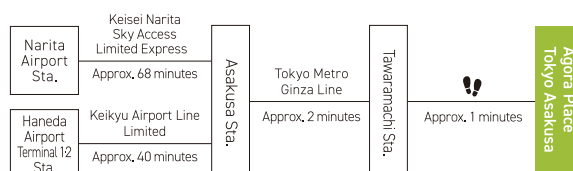

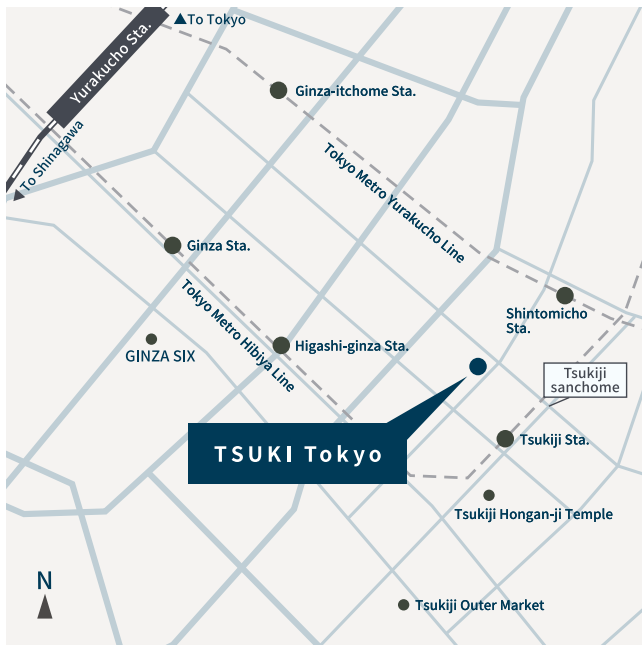

Kiyomizu-dera Temple

This is an old temple with a history of more than 1,200 years, said to have been founded in 778. Its most famous feature is the main hall, called "Kiyomizu-no-butai" (stage of Kiyomizu), which offers beautiful scenery during the cherry blossom season in spring and the autumn foliage season in fall.



Nijo Castle

Nijo Castle plays an important role as a historical building in Japan and was registered as a World Heritage Site by UNESCO in 1994 as a "Cultural Property of Ancient Kyoto" and in 2014 as a "Cultural Property of Kyoto"

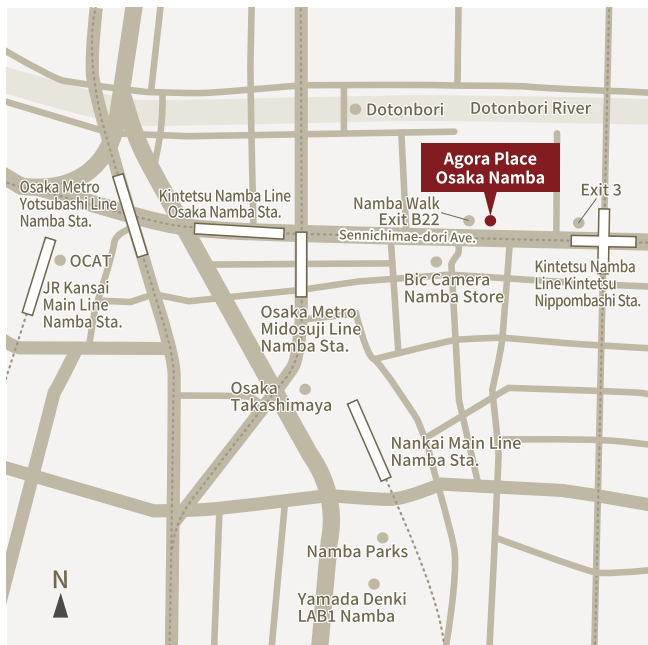
Osaka Takoyaki Museum

○Approx. 30 minutes by subway and on foot

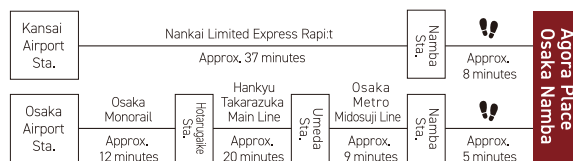
