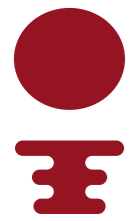

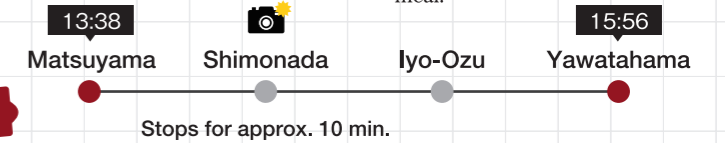

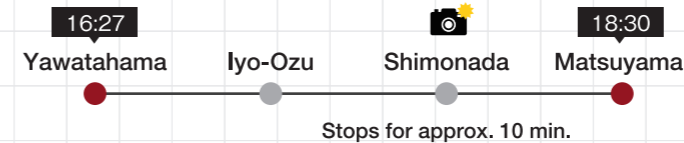
Take a journey to Yawatahama, a vibrant port town. Enjoy the changing scenery of the sea, river, and town with the train's original meal.

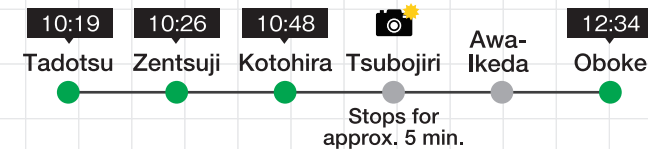

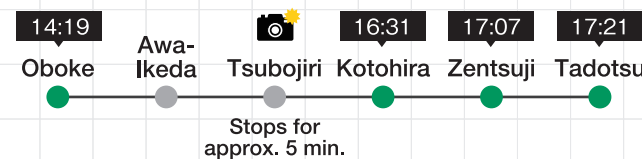

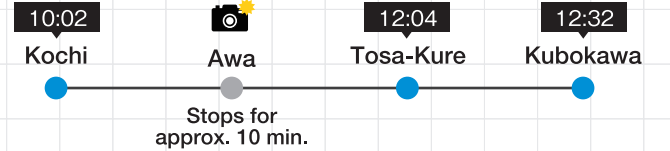
