"Narita International Airport, which serves as Japan's gateway to the world, also features excellent domestic flights. The airport is not only a strategic transportation point for Naritabi sightseeing, it is in itself a marvelous "airport sightseeing spot", where visitors can enjoy shopping, fine dining, art and panoramic views, among other things.



Every day, there are about 700 departures and arrivals at the airport, and the number of airport passengers has risen to more than 40 million per year. The airport also supports industry as a focal point for the international distribution of goods.



In fiscal 2015, the Number 3 Terminal at Narita Airport won the Good Design Grand Award of the Minister of Economy, Trade and Industry. The new terminal is helping to make air travel easier and more enjoyable.

Airport observation deck

There is an observation deck on the 5th floor of Terminal 1 and the 4th floor of Terminal 2. People never get tired of watching jets taking off and landing one after another.

Spots for photographing airplanes



This is a small but tall hill bordering on the airport. Chosen as one of the 100 best panoramic spots in Chiba, it is often used in filming for television. At the "Sora no Eki Sakura-kan" within the grounds, there are shops that sell things like vegetables and local specialty goods, as well as facilities such as restaurants, a tourist information center and shops for flight goods



Sanrizuka Sakura-no-Oka Park
In addition to facilities such as an observation deck, control tower, and maintenance area, this is a popular spot for getting close-up views of airplanes taking off and landing.

Toyomi Shinonome-no-Oka Park
Narita Airport's B runway is very close by, making this a highly recommended spot for feeling the power of aircraft as they come and go.

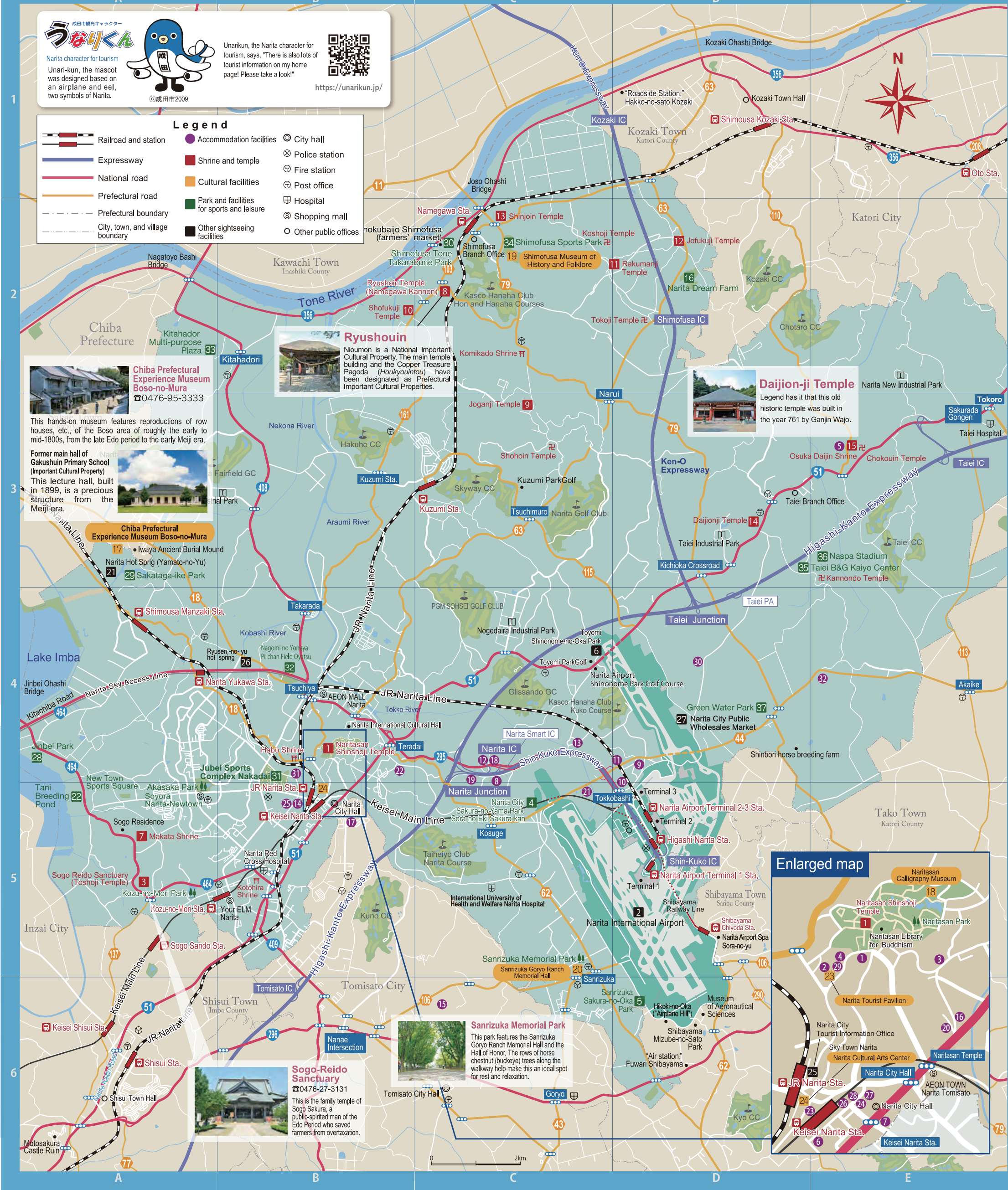
