Through Danjurou's work in helping to continue Japan's traditional performing arts and culture, he is spreading the word about Narita's attractions.





Naritasan Shinshoji Temple

This is Shinshoji, a temple rich in history, culture, and nature, a temple brimming with the atmosphere of an Edo temple town.

Walking... eating gourmet foods... experiencing... Every day here is a "Naritabi" day.

Naritasan Shinshoji Temple is the head temple of Shingonshu sect and is affectionately known as "Narita's O-Fudo-sama." The top-ranked of the "Big Three" temples of the Kanto region, it is visited by about 10 million people each year. In 1980, 5 important religious structures from relatively modern times were designated as important cultural properties: Komyodo Hall and Shakado Hall, which were formerly the main building, and the Three-storied Pagoda, Niomon Gate, and Gakudo Hall.





Three-storied Pagoda Illustrated map A (Important Cultural Property)

Built in 1712 and located in front of Great Main Hall, this 27-meter high pagoda conveys the spirit of the middle Edo Period to the modern era. In 2007, work was done to recreate the lacquered finish, and it was restored to its former splendor. It is dedicated
