

## Park Information

### Park Hours

9:30~17:00 (March 1st ~ July 20th/September 1st ~ October 31th)  
 9:30~18:00 (July 21th ~ August 31th)  
 9:30~16:30 (November 1st ~ the end of February)

### Admission Fees and Annual Passes

Children (junior high school students and under) are free.

- Seasonal pricing will be added for April/May and October.
- The exact period of seasonal pricing is subject to the actual growth conditions of the plants. The exact dates will be posted on our official website.
- Group Admission Fees apply to groups of 20 or more, which may consist of people of different age groups (adults, senior citizens and elementary and junior high school students).
- Proof of age (e.g. a driver's license) must be shown for the seniors (65 years old and over) rate.
- Visitors with a physical disability certificate, a rehabilitation certificate or a mental disability certificate are exempt from Admission and Parking fee by presenting a certificate. One accompanying person may enter free. However, the disability certificate must have been issued in Japan.
- Annual Passes are valid for one year from the date of purchase. Passes can be purchased at any park entrance.
- Annual Pass with parking fee can be issued for a registered vehicle of normal-size only.
- Both annual passes are valid in all the national parks where admission fees are applicable.
- 2-day tickets can be used only by the purchaser on the day of the purchase and the following day. The ticket is not transferable to other national parks.

- Reentry or change of parking lot are both acceptable upon presentation of the entrance fee receipt (valid only for the day).

### Park Closed on Tuesdays

- In the event that Tuesday is a National Holiday, the park will be closed on the following weekday
- Park closed on December 31st and January 1st. From the day before the first Tuesday in February to the following Friday.

### Every day open during the following periods

- Spring / March 26th ~ May 31th ● Summer / July 21th ~ August 31th
- Fall / October 1st ~ October 31th
- Winter / December 25th ~ December 30th January 2nd ~ January 7th

### Barrier-free Facility

Slope: Slopes are designed as pathways for people using wheelchairs.  
 Restroom: Most Restrooms in the park are equipped to suit the needs of handicapped persons.  
 Seaside Trains: Some of the seaside trains are equipped with special cars to assist people using wheelchairs when boarding.

### Baby carriages, wheelchairs or special cars for seniors are available for free rental.

Those wishing to utilize any of these special vehicles are advised to contact the park staff at any gate.

### First-Aid Offices

First-Aid offices are located at the Central Entrance. It's only open on Saturday, Sunday, and public holiday. When sick or injured, please contact park staff.

### To guests with pets

Guests with pets in the park are requested to use a leash at all times, take the waste away with you, observe good decorum and avoid disturbing other guests. Pets are not allowed inside any facilities (e.g. restaurants), or the attractions in the Pleasure Garden.

### Main items not allowed in the park

Bats(except made of vinyl), illegally transformed bicycles, one wheel cycles, roller skates, skate boards(roller shoes, kick boards included), drones, large size tents. For further information, please check the Information Display at any of the park entrances, or visit our official website.

### Other considerations

The taking or picking of plants or plants and animals is strictly prohibited by law. Smoking is strictly prohibited in the Park other than in the designated areas.

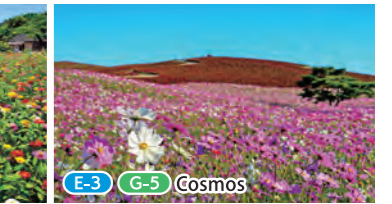

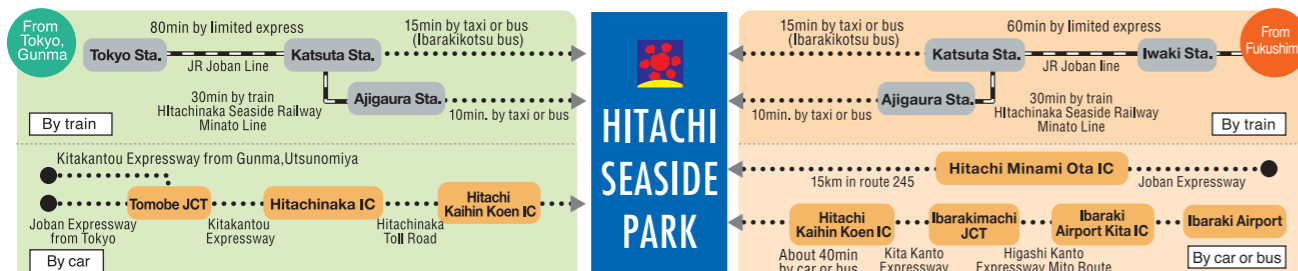

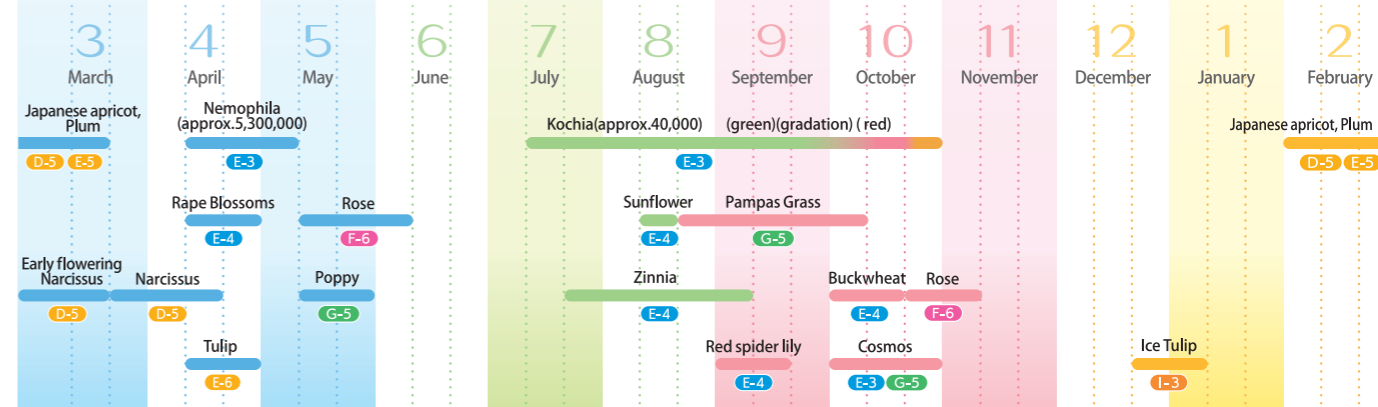

Hitachi Seaside Park is located on the Pacific Ocean side of the Japanese coast, and incorporates a unique natural environment of sand dunes, forests, grasslands and springs. With a total space of 350 hectares, of which 237 hectares are open to the public, this huge spacious park is home to a variety of colorful flowers and grasses throughout the four seasons, as well as numerous other attractions, including an amusement park, large grassland, cycling and BMX tracks, a forest athletics field, BBQs surrounding by nature, and many cafes and restaurants.

## Cafe, Restaurant & Shop

A variety of cafes, restaurants and shops in the park offer delicious food from Ibaraki Prefecture and sweets with seasonal flower motifs.



E-5 Kinen no Mori Rest House

The cafe terrace in the forest, where you can relax while enjoying original coffee of the Park along with sweets made from farm produce in Ibaraki.



L-3 Glass House / Sea Side Café

The giant glass windows of the Glass House provide a magnificent view of the Pacific Ocean. Enjoy drinks or snacks at the adjacent cafe. At certain designated times of the year, the cafe is open on weekends and public holidays only.



D-6 Lakeside Cafe

Take a quick break from watching the lake and water show. This snack cafe is only for takeout. (Note: At certain times of the year the cafe opens only on weekends and public holidays.)

G-6 1 Garden Restaurant  
In this spacious resort-style restaurant you can select from a wide range of foods from Ibaraki Prefecture. There's also an extensive takeout menu.

G-6 4 Kuma-san no Castilla  
Mr. Bear's delicious, bite-sized sponges and cakes are a popular choice! During summer, Mr. Bear's Shaved Ice is also available.

G-6 5 Pyong Pyong Kitchen  
A food stall where you can enjoy takeout snacks. At certain designated times of the year, the cafe is open on weekends and public holidays only.

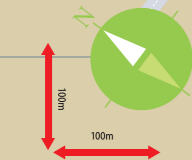
H-5 6 Soyokaze Kitchen

Giant Ferris Wheel is a symbol of the park. Enjoy the fun ride in the sky for 15 minutes. The view at the height of 100m offers a splendid panorama. When lost in the park, the wheel will always help you find your present location.

## Bicycle rental

Exclusive cycling course spanning about 13 km. Cycling is highly recommended to travel around this huge park. Let's actively explore the park!



- Walking on the cycling course is not permitted.
- Please return the cycle to one of the designated bicycle parking lots when you leave the course area.
- Bicycle rental hours are from 9:30 am until 30 minutes before the course is closed.
- Rentals are available at the West Entrance, Central Entrance, and Seabreeze Entrance Cycling Centers. (At the South Entrance, rentals are available only on Saturdays, Sundays and National Holidays.)
- Those bicycles brought in privately can be used with no fee payment in the course.

### Seaside Train

It only takes about 40 minutes to circle the entire park, riding on the breeze with the beautiful blue sea and white sand as a backdrop! You can get on and off easily at 9 different train stations inside the park.

One-day Round Trip Ticket  
**600 yen for one person**  
(3 years old and over are eligible to pay the fee)

One can ride with cash, Norinomo Ticket or Norinomo One-day Free Pass.

- There is a discount available for groups of 20 and over people.
- Strollers and wheel chairs can be taken on-board if folded.
- There is a special car on some trains that is wheelchair accessible.
- All passengers (including the handicapped) must pay the fee. However, upon presentation of a disability certificate, up to one accompanying person shall be exempted from paying.
- Unfortunately, we cannot accept passengers with pets on the Seaside Train.
- Special and direct flights may operate depending on the season.

Neither Norinomo Ticket nor One-day Free Pass is valid for bike rentals.
