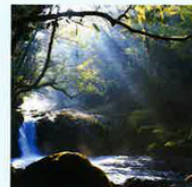
Kikuchi Gorge is where underground water from the outer rim of Mt. Aso and unspoiled forests creates diversified views. Following a promenade, visitors can enjoy the natural beauty of the gorge which changes every season. There are many viewpoints, such as Ryu-ga-fuchi, the water pool where a dragon is said to have lived, Momiji-ga-se, the shoal which is covered with moss during summer and a carpet of colored leaves during autumn. It is a vast and unbelievable world of natural beauty. The average water temperature here is 14 degrees, and it is a destination of resort in summer, acting as a natural air conditioner. It is also popular in winter due to fantastic fog ice.

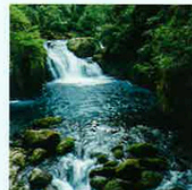

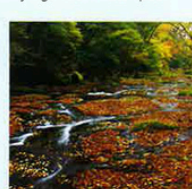

Town associated with the Kikuchi Family, heroes in the period of the northern and southern dynasties

## History/Culture

The Kikuchi Family, the aristocrats who ruled the Kyushu area. Many of their traces are still left, mainly in the Waifu area.



Stroll around the area, following the history of the prosperous Kikuchi Family

The Kikuchi Family is a samurai family who had been prosperous mainly in the Kikuchi area in Higo Province (Kumamoto) for 450 years from the latter part of the Heian Period (794-1185) to the Muromachi Period (1336-). The name is found in famous Japanese classics, including "Genji Monogatari", "Mohko-syurai-ezu", and "Taihei-ki", and it was the major aristocratic family in Kyushu whose fame spread even to the central part of Japan. Traces of the history left by 24 generations of the family are still clearly found in various places in Kikuchi City. In addition, there are many other nice places to visit, including a historic stone bridge which harmonizes with a country view, an old mountain castle, and many others. Please take time and enjoy the history of the area.

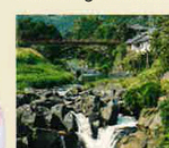

There are many places in Kikuchi which have breathtaking views of cherry blossoms. Including Kikuchi Shrine and Kikuchi Park.

Townscape with history, nature, and abundant cherry trees

From late March to early April every year, cherry blossoms brighten up the traditional streets with pink color. Commanding broad view of the city, Kikuchi Park has 3,000 cherry trees of 22 varieties, and they look quite spectacular when illuminated by Japanese paper lanterns at night. Along the approach of Kikuchi Shrine near the park, a tunnel of cherry flowers appears, which creates a mysterious world during this season. In addition, there are many famous places for cherry blossoms all over the area. It is a wonderful season for a drive to see cherry blossoms.

## Changing of seasons



Fireflies in the Takayanagi area (late May-early June)

Fantastic views unique of a water town

Kikuchi City, with its crystal clear water, is famous for fireflies. Especially the wild dancing by Genji fireflies is spectacular. The Nikaki and Watase rivers in the Kyokushi area are popular spots above all. On humid days with little wind, thousands of fireflies dance in the night sky.

The Isaka area, home of spider lilies (mid-September)

A famous rice producer, Kikuchi shows off its beautiful local views with golden yellow ears of rice and red spider lilies in September. In particular, the 100,000 spider lilies in the Isaka area attract visitors. These spider lilies were transplanted from the Hanjaku area in 1991 before it was submerged due to the construction of the Ryumon Dam.

A carpet of cosmos blooming all over

When you drive in the Kikuchi area in fall, lovely cosmos flowers planted in various places are a feast for your eyes. Among them, riverbeds of the Kikuchi River and the Hazama River in Shichijo are famous as spots where cosmos in full bloom spread all over. And in the riverbed of the Kikuchi River, a 3-4 km carpet of pink flowers spreads out with 150,000 cosmos seedlings.

Meet gigantic trees in power spots imbued with spiritual energy

Visit the site of a natural monument designated by Kumamoto Prefecture to see gigantic trees and historical trees designated as Kikuchi heritage sites. Each tree has its own legend, and listening to the explanation associated to each tree is most intriguing for visitors.

The temple, however, was rebuilt in 1942, and now many priests from in and out of Japan visit here to undergo training. 299 step stairs are a masterpiece!

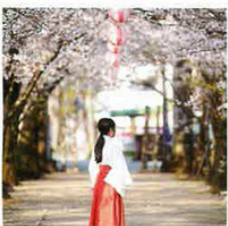

Kikuchi rice has been recognized as synonymous for tasty rice since the Edo period (1600-1867). Shichijo-no-Kome (Shichijo rice) is among the best and most highly-esteemed in Japan. It has received the highest award, a special A grade, of the eating quality ranking by the Japan Grain Inspection Association a number of times

**Pork**  
Kikuchi is one of the main regions for stockbreeding and pig farming is widespread, producing Rindo pork, Moromi pork, SPF pork, and other quality brands. Rindo pork boasts a fine and soft texture and a subtle sweet flavor since the pigs are fed a special meal with quality starch of wheat, natural vitamins, and minerals.

**Kyokushi beef**  
Kyokushi beef, a product Kikuchi's rich nature, is meltingly delicious with a wonderful flavor. It has a good balance of quality lean meat and fat, and it is full of juiciness when cooked.

**Melons**  
April to June September to sometime around December  
A variety of melons are cultivated, mainly in Shichijo-machi, such as the fragrant, elegant, and sweet Earl's melon and the Higo Green, which is characterized by its thick flesh. One can enjoy them in any season except midwinter.

**Yacon and Jerusalem artichokes**  
November to sometime around March

August to sometime around October  
Kumamoto Prefecture is the second largest production district of chestnuts. Kikuchi's are large and feature mouth-melting deliciousness with a crumbly texture.

**Burdocks** by paddy cultivation  
Late November to sometime around late May  
A product of the fertile soil, they are harvested in spring and winter. Their original white skin color, the distinct flavor and texture, and fine fiber are hallmarks of fine burdocks.

**Kikuchi Furusato Sosei Shimin Hiroba Plaza** City area MAP ①  
The plaza was established to advertise the charm of Kikuchi and to promote its prosperity. It has space to encourage citizens' communication while spending time for relaxation. With a sculpture of Takemitsu, the 15th lord of the Kikuchi Family, in the center of the plaza, it has a lawn, playground equipment, a roofed footbath, and a public square with a large roof so that citizens can enjoy time here even on rainy days. The Kikuchi Product Promotion Center and Kikuchi Tourism Center are located next to the plaza.
