Tanabata 七夕

Tanabata, Star Festival is held on July 7 in most parts of Japan or August 7 in some areas. Based on a Chinese folk legend in which two starts - Altair (Cowherd) and Vega (Weaver) - love each other but only allowed to cross the Milky Way to meet once a year on this day.

Wishes are written on long colored strips of paper and hung from a bamboo branch with other decorations.

Ukai 鵜飼

Cormorant fishing, an ancient method of catching Ayu (sweetfish or trout-like fish), handling cormorants.

This usually takes place at night under the blazing torches fastened to the prows of fishing boats from May until October.

Wishes are written on long colored strips of paper and hung from a bamboo branch with other decorations.
