Obon お盆
Obon is a Buddhist event held in July (if following the lunar calendar) or August 13-15. Ancestral spirits are invited into the home to be honored. *Bon-Odori* (folk dance) are also held, with people in *Yukata* - summer *Kimono*, dancing in a circle. Many people take summer vacations during this time and return to their hometowns to visit family homes.

Ukai 鵜飼
Cormorant fishing, an ancient method of catching *Ayu* (sweetfish or trout-like fish), handling cormorants. This usually takes place at night under the blazing torches fastened to the prows of fishing boats from May until October.
