
Tateyama-Kurobe Alpine Route (立山黒部アルペンルート)

The route for crossing the Northern Japan Alps by various means of transportation between Shinano-Omachi and Toyama takes about 8 hrs. to look around. You can enjoy the alpine nature without heavy climbing equipment. Sneakers, a rainwear and a cold weather outfit are necessary. The whole transportation network is operated only from mid Apr. to late Nov. The peak period are summer and the season of autumnal leaves (late Sep. thru late Oct.).

Gokayama (五箇山)

Nestled along the deep gorge of the Sho river. 29 of total 60 Gassho-zukuri houses, located in two hamlets of Suganuma and Ainokura (see page 3/4), have been well preserved and form part of UNESCO's World Heritage Site with Shirakawago village in the south.





Recommended Walking Route

Murododaira Hiking Route (室堂平周辺散策コース)(1 to 2-hour hike)

Located at the highest point of the Tateyama Kurobe Alpine Route, Murodo offers a choice of numerous hiking routes. The area around Murodo boasts many noteworthy sights, among them Mikurigaike Pond and Jigokudani Valley. In particular, views of the Tateyama Mountains reflectded in the clear waters of Mikurigaike Pond are something that cannot be missed.


Jigokudani is still an active hot spring and water vapor also spouts out, therefore it is very dangerous. Do not enter Jigokudani as



well as closed or outside of designated course to avoid accidents caused by volcanic gas. The route around Mikurigaike Pond takes about 1 hr. to hike. The route is closed from December until March. Watch your step as the walking trail is covered with snow in Spring and Autumn.

Midagahara Hiking Route (弥陀ヶ原周辺散策コース)(1 or 2-hour hike)

Midagahara is an area of highlands and is 2,000 meters above sea level. Even the marsh is maintained as a promenade. A short course will take about 1 hr., and the long course will take about 2 hrs. Various wild flowers of the highlands can be seen in Jul. and Aug. You can enjoy the fall foliage in Oct.



Other Places of Interest:

Kurobe Gorge(黒部峡谷)

This is the route of the tramcar going through Kurobe Gorge from Unazuki to Keyakidaira. Along the line there are many places specializing in outdoor baths (Rotenburo) such as Kuronagi and Kanetsuri. From the tramcar called Kurobe Kyokoku Railways you can enjoy the panorama of the Northern Japan Alps.

Access: 1 hr. 45 min. from Dentetsu Toyama Sta. to Unazuki Onsen by Toyama Chiho Railways.

Fare: ¥1,880 (one-way) 5 min. walk from Unazuki Onsen Sta. to Unazuki Sta. of Kurobe Gorge Railways.

Kurobe Gorge Railways (黑部峡谷鉄道): Operated only from early May thru Nov. 30.

Fare (one-way): to Kanetsuri ¥1,410

to Keyakidaira ¥1,980

During summer vacation and the season of autumnal foliage it's crowded and difficult to get tickets. Making reservations through travel agencies is recommended.

Gokayama Area (五箇山)

Gokayama is a prefectural natural park located in the south western part of Toyama Prefecture. In this area there are many houses preserved in the classical Japanese country style dating from the 17th century. Its architectural style is called "Gassho-zukuri". The two hamlets of Suganuma and Ainokura, where these houses are concentrated, were designated by UNESCO as a World Heritage Site in 1995 along with Shirakawago, another Gassho-zukuri house hamlet several kilometers away from Gokayama.

·Suganuma (菅沼)

Suganuma Gassho Shuraku(菅沼合掌集落): A neighborhood of a group of 9 Gassho-zukuri houses.

Gokayama Folklore Museum (五箇山民俗館): A museum

of village daily life. This building is also a Gassho-zukuri house. Hours: 9:00–16:00. Closed: New Year holiday. Admission: ¥300.

·Nishiakao (西赤尾)

The Iwase Residence (岩瀬家): An Important Cultural Property. The largest Gassho-zukuri house in Gokayama. Hours: 8:00–17:00. Admission: ¥300.

·Ainokura (相倉)

Ainokura Gassho Shuraku(相倉合掌集落): A group of 20 Gassho-zukuri style houses.

Ainokura Folk Museum (相倉民俗館): A museum of folk culture such as sericulture, paper-making and traditional tools of daily life in two real Gassho-zukuri houses. You can also observe the structure from inside. Hours: 8:30–17:00. Admission: ¥300.

·Kaminashi (上梨)

The Murakami Residence(村上家): Important Cultural Property. Hours: 8:30–17:00. Closed: Wed. (except national holidays), New Year holiday. Admission: ¥300.

·Higashinakae (東中江)

Gokayama Washi-no-Sato (五箇山和紙の里): Gokayama is famous for its paper products. In this center you can watch a short video of paper-making process and try by yourself. Hours: 9:00–17:00 Closed: Dec. 29–Jan. 3. Paper-making: ¥700–.

•Toga Village (利賀村)

Toga Meisou-no-Sato (利賀瞑想の郷)

Having a theme of "healing and comfort," this facility was built as a symbol of friendship with Tukche Village in Nepal. It features a four-square-meter mandala and exhibits and sells Buddhist paintings, accessories imported from Nepal, and other items. Hours: 9:00–16:00. Closed: Wed. Admission: ¥600.

Toga Arts Park of Toyama Prefecture(富山県利賀芸 術公園): World-known theater spot with Japan's first International Theatre Festival "Toga Festival" (1982-1999), by Tadashi Suzuki and his company SCOT. Celebrating the new

millenium, a new program Toga Summer Arts Program started in 2000, a project of performance, competition, education and conference on performing arts.
