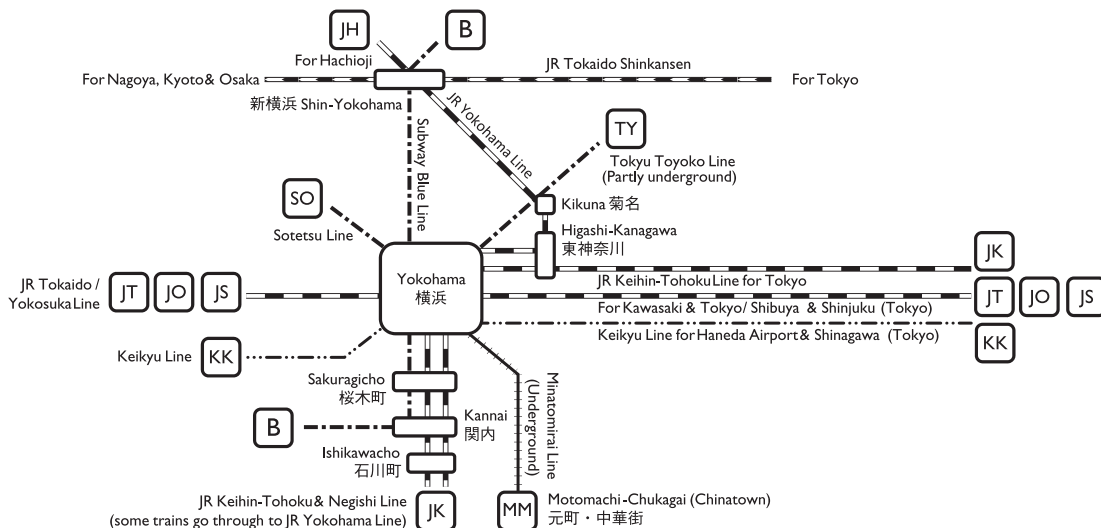
Yokohama (横浜), pop. 3,748,781, (as of Oct. 2019) the capital of Kanagawa Prefecture, is situated just 30 km south of Tokyo. Since Yokohama Port opened in 1859, it has become Japan's

largest and most prosperous maritime trading center. You will find Yokohama attractive for its sights, entertainment and history.

Economical One-day Pass for visitors:

Minato-Burari Ticket (¥500 for adult, ¥250 for child) offers unlimited ride on Subway Blue Line & the city bus in designated zone covering the city center. The pass also covers hop-on hop-off sightseeing bus routes called "**Akai Kutsu**" bus (2 routes daily) and "**Burari**" bus (1 route daily & 2 routes on weekends & holidays) that make your trip more flexible. In addition, special offers are provided only for the ticket holders at more than 80 associated facilities. Available at major stations on Subway Blue Line (e.g. Yokohama Sta. and Sakuragicho Sta.), Tourist Information Center (Sakuragicho Sta.) and major locations (hotels & stores) within the designated zone.

*If you start your trip from / to Shin-yokohama Sta. on JR Tokaido Shinkansen line, **Minato Burari Ticket Wide** (¥550 for adult, ¥280 for child) covers a round-trip route (by Subway Blue Line) between the station and the city center. Available at Tourist Information Center (Shin-Yokohama Sta.) and the sales locations above.

Places of Interest:

① **Yokohama Museum of Art** (横浜美術館), specializes in modern and contemporary art. The building was designed by Kenzo Tange, a noted Japanese architect. Access: 3 min. walk from Minato-Mirai Sta. Open: 10:00–18:00, Closed: Thu. & New Year holiday. Admission: ¥500 for Permanent Collections (fees differ in each exhibition).

② **Kanagawa Prefectural Museum of Cultural History** (神奈川県立歴史博物館), was constructed in 1904 in the German Neobaroque-style and has been declared an Important Cultural Property. It features exhibits on people's lives from ancient times to the present as well as on the relations between Japan and foreign countries. The museum traces the history of the opening of Yokohama Port. Access: 8 min. walk from Kannai or Sakuragicho Sta. or 1 min. walk from Bashamichi Sta. Open: 9:30–17:00 Closed: Mon. (except national holidays) & New Year holiday Admission: ¥300 for Permanent Exhibitions (fees differ in each exhibition).

③ **Silk Museum** (シルク博物館) The museum displays the silk manufacturing process and various kinds of silk products. Access: 15 min. walk from Kannai Sta. or 3 min. walk from Nihon-Odori Sta. Open: 9:30–17:00, Closed: Mon. (or the following day after the holiday[s] when Mon. falls on a national holiday), New Year holiday and others. Admission: ¥500.

④ **Yokohama Doll Museum** (横浜人形の家), facing Yamashita Park, houses over 10,000 dolls from around the world. Access: 13 min. walk from Ishikawacho Sta. or 3 min. walk from Motomachi-Chukagai Sta. Open: 9:30–17:00, Closed: Mon. (or the following day after the holiday[s] when Mon. falls on a national holiday) & New Year holiday. Admission: ¥400.

⑤ **Mitsubishi Minatomirai Industrial Museum** (三菱みなとみらい技術館) is in Mitsubishi Juko Yokohama Bldg. Access: 8 min. walk from Sakuragicho Sta. or 3 min. walk from Minato-Mirai Sta. Open: 10:00–17:00, Closed: Tue. (or the following day after the holiday[s] when Tue. falls on a national holiday), New Year holiday and on specified closed days (check the [website](#)). Admission: ¥500.

⑥ **Yokohama Park** (横浜公園) was constructed in 1876. Yokohama Stadium, the home ground of Yokohama DeNA Baystars Baseball Team, is in the park. Access: 5 min. walk from Kannai Sta.

⑦ **Yamashita Park** (山下公園), one of the oldest seaside park in Japan, stretches for about 1,000 meters along Yokohama Harbor.

⑧ **Chinatown** (中華街), bordered by four different-colored Chinese gates (called Pairo) facing each compass direction, is built around the Chinese shrine called Kanteibyō, which enshrines the god of commerce. The blue east gate signifies prosperity, the white west one peace, the red south one happiness and the black north one posterity. About 600 restaurants and shops line its bustling streets. Access: 1 min. walk from Motomachi-Chukagai Sta. Refer to the map of Chinatown on page 4/7.

⑨ **Yokohama Foreign General Cemetery** (外国人墓地) lies on the bluff commanding a grand view of the city. The cemetery contains some 3,000 graves of foreigners who contributed to Japan's opening to the world. Open: Graves 12:00–16:00 on Sat., Sun. & national holiday (Feb.-Jul. & Sep.-Dec.). Admission is free, but donation for maintaining graves is required. Access: 5 min. walk from Motomachi-Chukagai Sta.

⑩ **Harbor View Park** (港の見える丘公園) is a hilltop park which offers a good view of the harbor area. Access: 5 min. walk from Motomachi-Chukagai Sta. or 10 min. walk from "Minatonomieru-oka-koen-mae" bus stop from Sakuragicho Sta.

⑪ **Sankeien Garden** (三溪園), a purely Japanese-style landscape garden, was originally laid out by Tomitaro Hara (1868–1939) one of the big raw silk exporters in Yokohama. Accenting the main garden is an impressive three-story pagoda and graceful garden bridges. An inner garden contains several old houses and farm buildings as well as Important Cultural Properties such as Rinshunkaku Villa and Choshukaku House. Access: 35 min. by bus from Sakuragicho Sta. to "Homomoku-Sankeien-mae" bus stop then 5 min. walk. Open: 9:00–17:00, Closed: Dec. 29–31 Admission: ¥700.

⑫ **Yokohama Bay Bridge** (横浜ベイブリッジ) is the gateway to the Yokohama Port. This suspension bridge, 860 meters long and 3 lanes wide on each side, with 176 cables stretching diagonally from the pillars supporting the bridge, is a part of the Metropolitan Expressway.

⑬ **Yokohama Landmark Tower** (横浜ランドマークタワー) is 296 meters high with 70 stories above ground and three levels underground. There are many shops, restaurants and a hotel. Visitors can also enjoy the panoramic view. A 40-second ride on the fast elevator skyrockets you to the 69th floor's Sky Garden. Open: 10:00–21:00, –22:00 (Sat., & Sun. when Mon. is a national holiday). Access: 3 min. walk from Minato-Mirai Sta. or 5 min. walk from Sakuragicho Sta. Admission: ¥1,000.

⑭ **Pacifico Yokohama** (パシフィコ横浜) is a major international convention center consisting of a convention hall, conference center, and an exhibition hall. On the premises is Yokohama Grand Inter Continental Hotel, 31-story high and built in the form of a sail. Access: 5 min. walk from Minato-Mirai Sta.

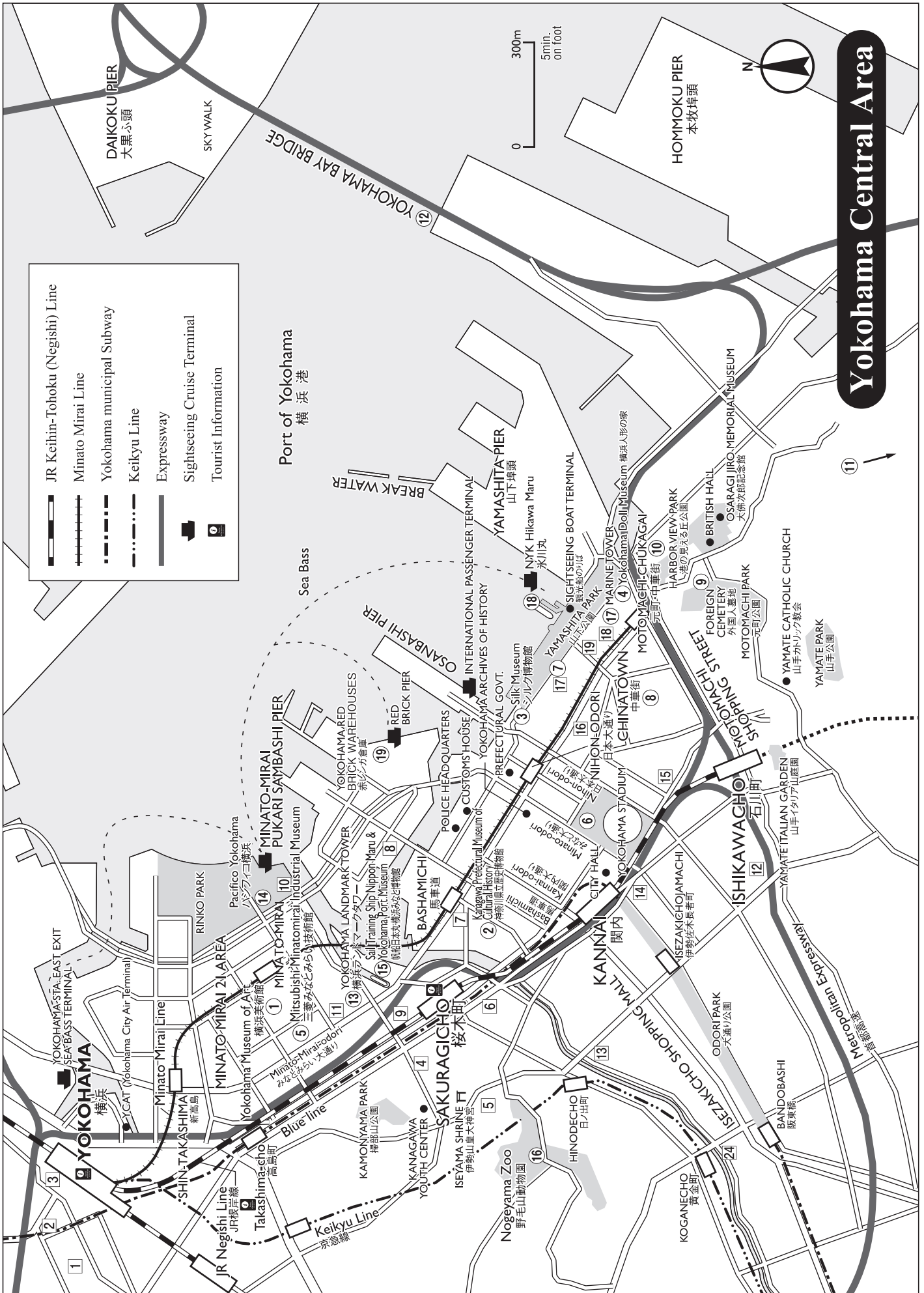
⑮ **Sail Training Ship Nippon Maru & Yokohama Port Museum** (帆船日本丸・横浜みなと博物館) Nippon-Marū was built in 1930 for students of the mercantile schools. Trained volunteer open all sails and display the full-sailed ship about 12 times a year. The Yokohama Port Museum, which specializes in ports and ships, is located next to the Nippon Maru. Access: 5 min. walk from Sakuragicho Sta. Open: 10:00–17:00. Closed: Mon. (or the following day after the holiday[s] when Mon. falls on a national holiday) & New Year holiday. Admission: ¥600.

⑯ **Nogeyama Zoo** (野毛山動物園) has about 1500 animals. Access: 15 min. walk from Sakuragicho Sta. Open: 9:30–16:30, Closed: Mon. (or the following day after the holiday[s] when Mon. falls on a national holiday) & Dec.29–Jan.1. Admission: free.

⑰ **Marine Tower** (マリンタワー) is 106 m high with an observatory located 94 m above ground. Access: 1 min. walk from Motomachi-Chukagai Sta. Open: 10:00–22:30. Admission: ¥750.

⑱ **NYK Hikawa Maru** (氷川丸) is a 11,622 ton passenger ship used from 1930 to 1960. Access: 3 min. walk from Motomachi-Chukagai Sta. Open: 10:00-17:00, Closed: Mon. (or the following day after the holiday[s] when Mon. falls on a national holiday) & Jan.21-25. Admission: ¥300.

⑲ **Yokohama Red Brick Warehouses** (横浜赤レンガ倉庫) were built as national warehouses between 1911–1913 and operated as a logistics exchange point of the port of Yokohama. Now they are used as cultural and commercial facilities. The shopping mall in the second warehouse is open 11:00–20:00 (restaurants: depend on each shops). Access: 6 min. walk from Bashamichi Sta. or Nihon-odori Sta.

Zoorasia Yokohama Zoological Gardens (よこはま動物園ズーラシア) is a zoological garden with 8 different themes. As Asian Tropical Forest, Subarctic Forest, Oceanian Glassland, Central Asian Highland, Japanese Countryside, African Tropical Rain Forest, Amazon Jungle, and African Savanna. It is designed to keep animals in conditions as close to their natural inhabitants as possible. Access: 15 min. bus ride for Yokohama-dobutsuen from Tsurugamine Sta. or Mitsukyo Sta. on Sotetsu Line, or Nakayama Sta. on JR Yokohama Line Open: 9:30–16:30, Closed: Tue. (or Wed. when Tue. is a national holiday) Dec.29–Jan.1 Admission: Adults ¥800 (Child ¥200).

Yokohama Hakkeijima Sea Paradise (横浜・八景島シーパラダイス), an artificial island, houses Japan's largest aquarium. Access: 7 min. ride from Kanazawa-hakkei Sta. or 20 min. ride from Shin-sugita Sta. to Hakkeijima Sta. by Seaside Line Open: 8:30–21:30 (Mon.–Fri.), –22:30 (Sat., Sun., summer & national holidays) Opening hours change with the season and the day. Admission: ¥3,000 (Aqua Resorts Pass), ¥5,200 (One-day pass).

Kirin Yokohama Beer Village, allows visitors to tour the Kirin Beer Brewery (reservation required), which also has a pub and restaurants. Access: 10 min. walk from Namamugi Sta. on Keikyū Line Open: 10:00–17:00 Closed: Mon. (or Tue. When Mon. is a national holiday) Admission: free.

Yokohama International Swimming Pool is a comprehensive sports center which has facilities such as a pool, a training room and tennis courts. Access: 10 min. ride to Kokusai Pool Seimon-mae Bus Stop by Tokyu Bus from Center-kita Sta. Open: 9:30–22:30 (enter by 21:45), 7:30–21:30 (Sat. Sun. & national holidays, enter by 20:45) Closed: Depend on days and events Admission: ¥700 for 2hrs.

Yokohama History Museum (横浜市歴史博物館) displays around the theme of the “People who lived in Yokohama” deal with the history of the city environs over a 20,000 year period. Access: 5 min. walk from Center-kita Sta. Open: 9:00–17:00, Closed: Mon. (or Tue. when Mon. is a national holiday) & the New Year's holiday Admission: ¥400 (permanent exhibition).

Places of Interest:

NISSAN STADIUM (日産スタジアム) allows visitors to tour the stadium irregularly (60 min. course ¥500), and English-speaking guides are available. **NISSAN WATER PARK** (indoor amusement pool) in the stadium is open to the public. Open: 9:00–21:00, –17:00 (Sun. & national holidays), –19:30 (Sun. & national holidays in Jul.–Aug.) enter by 1 hr. before each closing time Closed: 3rd Tue. (or Wed. when Tue. is a holiday), 3rd Tue. and 4th Tue. (Jan.–Mar.) & the New Year's holiday Access: 15 min. walk from Shin-Yokohama Sta. Admission: ¥500 per hour & surcharge ¥250 per 30 min.

Shin-Yokohama Raumen Museum (新横浜ラーメン博物館) presents the history of ramen or Chinese noodles. Two basement levels are laid out to look like a 1960s town and feature nine different types of ramen restaurants. Access: 5 min. walk from Shin-Yokohama Sta. Open: 11:00–22:00 (depends on the day), Ramen shops take orders until 30 min. before closing time. Admission: ¥380.

Major Events in Yokohama:

Feb.: Shunsetsu, or Chinese New Year's Day occurs according to the lunar calendar in Chinatown. Chinese entertainment galore including the ever-popular dragon dance.
 May.: Minato Festival, the Yokohama fancy dress parade with baton twirlers and folk dancers starts in front of Yamashita Park, passing along main streets of the city.
 Late May.: Yokohama Port Opening Anniversary Bazaar, a huge annual bazaar is held for one week at Yokohama Koen (park) adjacent to Yokohama Stadium.
 Jun.: Yokohama Port Festival at Rinkou Park (Minato Mirai 21 Area), many marine events are held during the day. (live concerts, fire works, etc.)
 Oct. 1: National Festival (anniversary of the founding of the People's Republic of China at Chinatown)
 Oct. 10: Sojusetu (Double Ten Day) is celebrated in Chinatown.
 Early-Oct.: Yokohama Jazz Promenade, you can enjoy hundreds of jazz sessions at more than 90 places (Hikawa Maru concert halls, live houses in Yokohama, etc.).
 Oct. 31-Nov.3: Bashamichi Festival
 Late Sep.-Early-Oct.: Yokohama October Festival

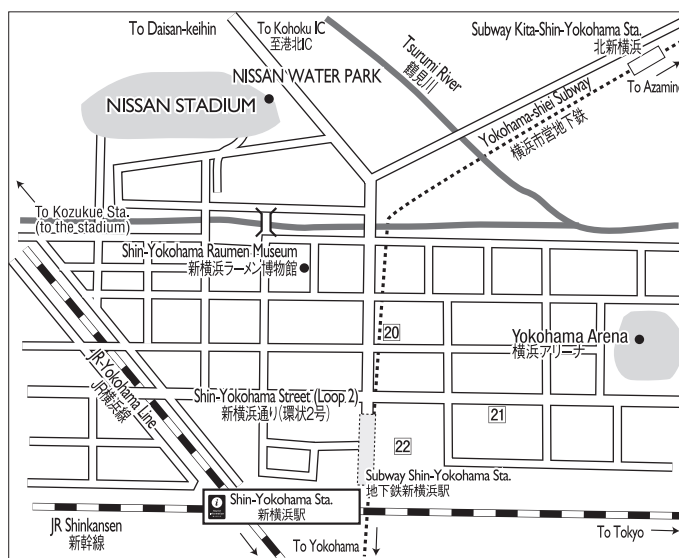
