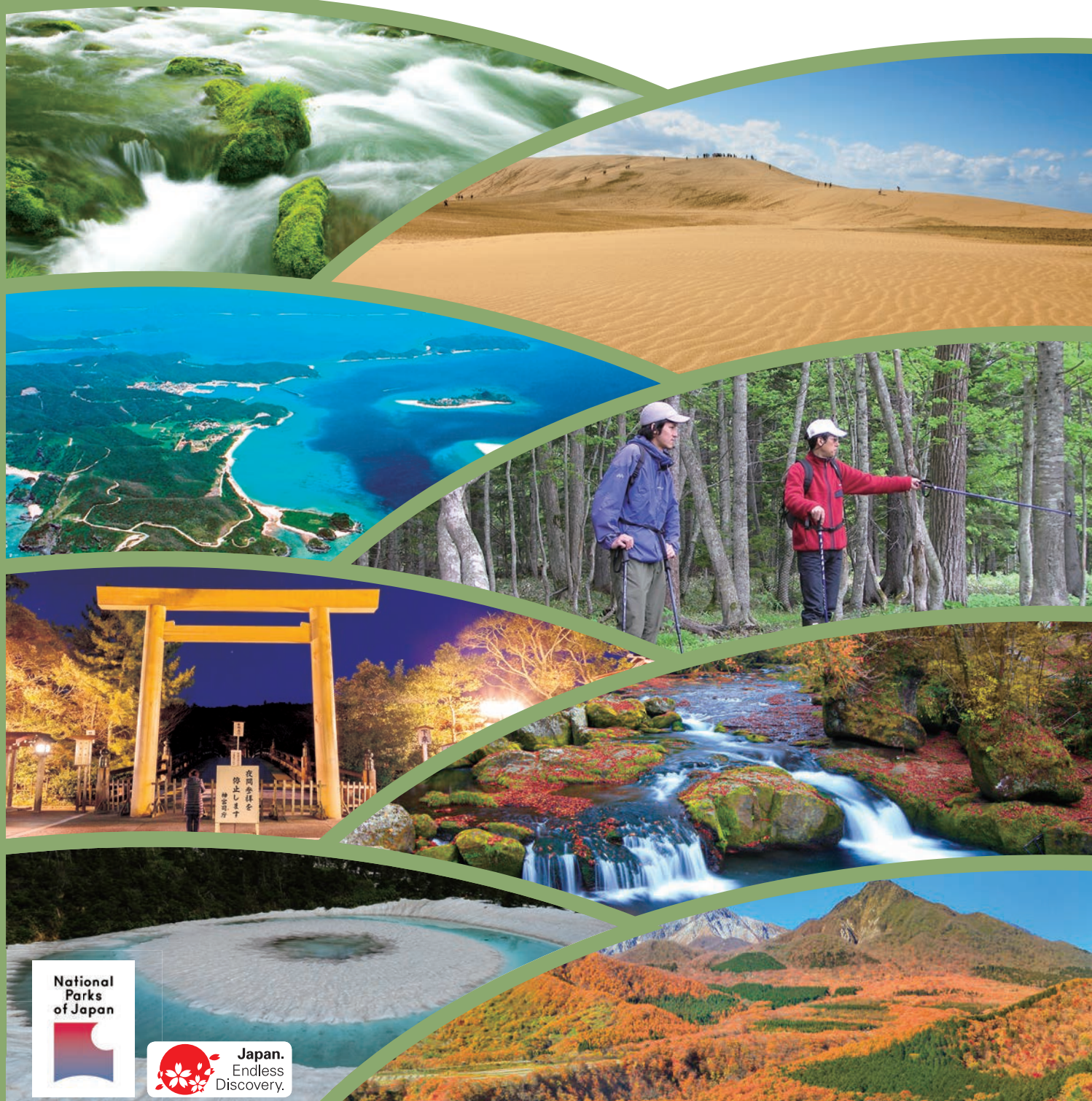

Towada-Hachimantai National Park

Date of Designation: Feb. 1, 1936

This area covers some of the country's most iconic natural wonders, Lake Towada and Oirase Stream; the broadleaf forests and alpine plants of Hachimantai; and many more. There are also therapeutic hot springs in this area since ancient times.

Ise-Shima National Park

Date of Designation: Nov. 20, 1946

This area consists of the Shima Peninsula, known for its exquisite scenery of an intricately formed ria coastline, as well as Ise Jingu, a symbol of faith and tradition since days of old. The mountains deep in the area are preserved for the forests where timber used to build the shrine was sourced. There are beech trees, cedar trees and Japanese red pine trees spread throughout.

Shiretoko National Park

Date of Designation: June 1, 1964

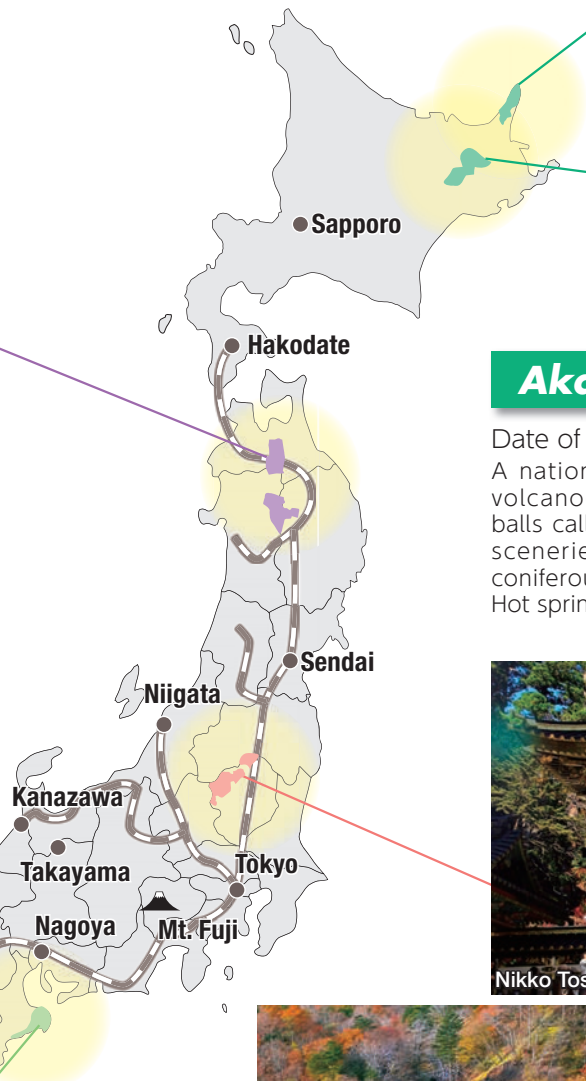
A national park featuring the pristine nature of the Shiretoko Peninsula. Diverse wildlife including brown bears, Steller's sea eagles and Steller sea lions inhabit this region. During winter, the sea becomes blocked off by drift ice. Shiretoko was designated as a World Natural Heritage Site in July 2005.

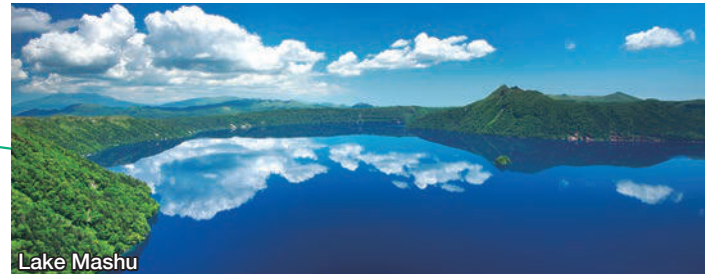

Akan-Mashu National Park

Date of Designation: Dec. 4, 1934

A national park comprised of forests, lakes and volcanoes. It boasts of Lake Akan, where algae balls called marimo can be found, and breathtaking sceneries of three caldera lakes surrounded by coniferous forests. Many species of birds live here. Hot springs also well up from several areas.

Nikko National Park

Date of Designation: Dec. 4, 1934

This park features a diverse range of landscapes from the historical architecture of the Nikko Toshogu Shrine to the Lake Chuzenji area, a popular summer retreat up in the mountains. It is easily accessible as it is situated near the Greater Tokyo Area.

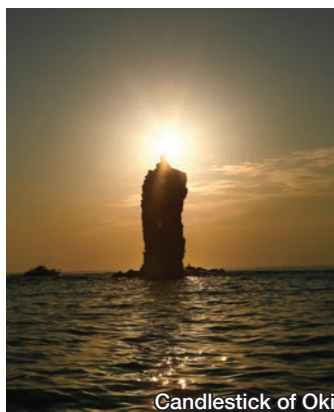

This national park covers many coral reefs and some 30 islands large and small dotting the waters 40 km west of Naha City. This is the first national park where the ocean covers 7 km, the majority of the area.

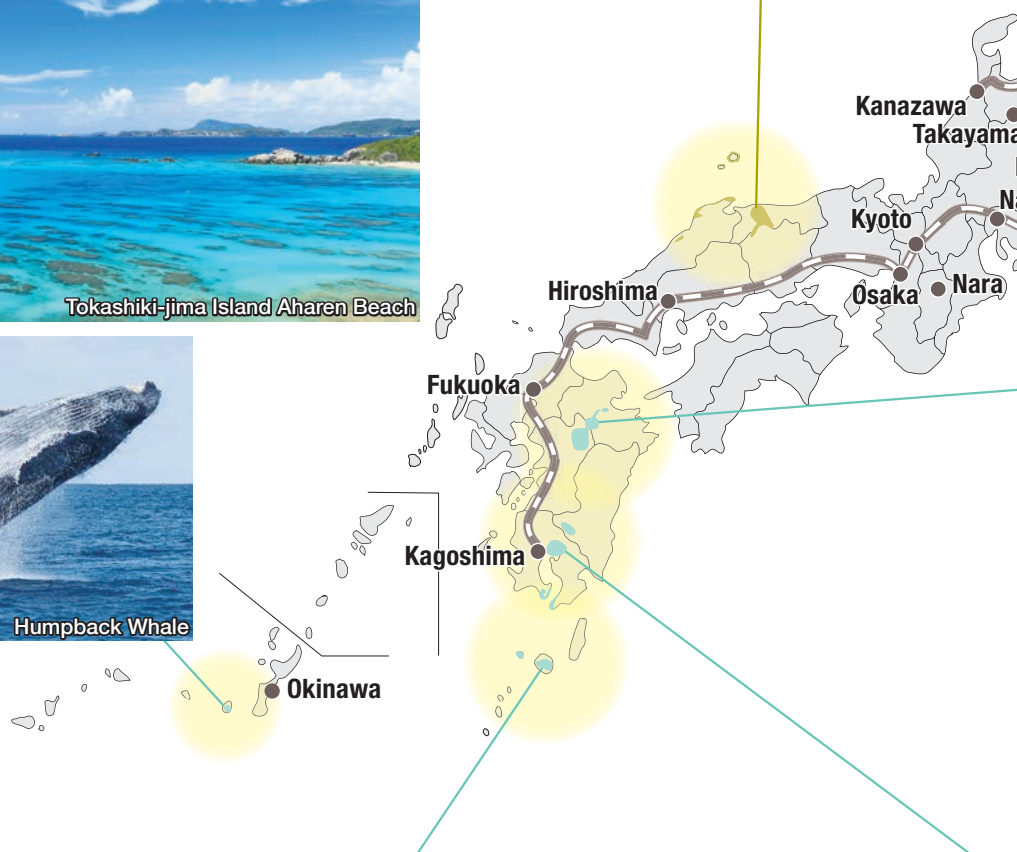

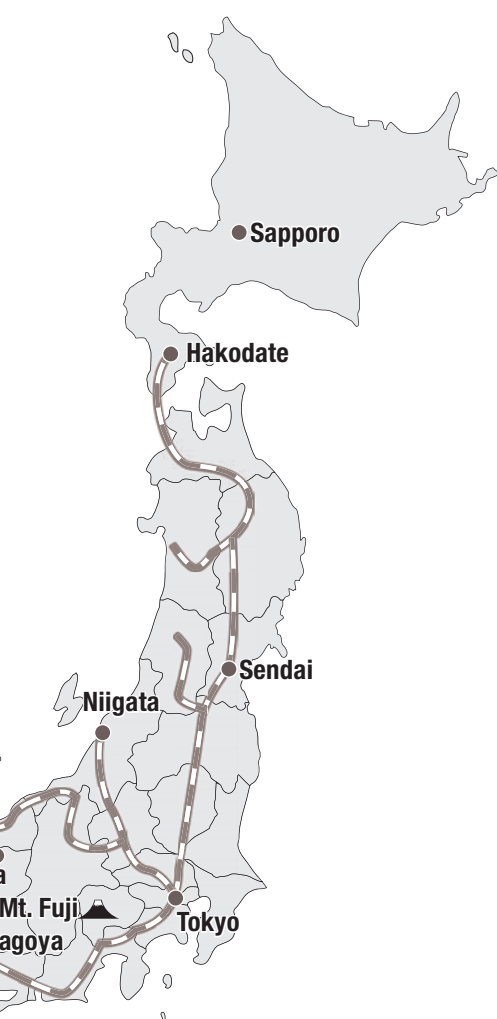

Designated as a World Natural Heritage Site in December 1993, Yakushima is known for natural forests where Yakusugi, Japanese cedar trees over a thousand years old, can be found. The island is also home to a diverse range of plant life due to vertical distribution from the coastal area to Mt. Miyanoura, the highest peak in the Kyushu area at 1,936 meters.



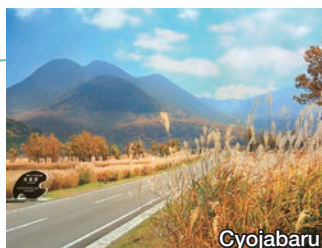
